DESCRIPTION

What is the difference between abuse resistant and impact resistant gypsum board? What are the different types of abuse and impact resistant gypsum boards available? How do these products compare with regular gypsum or alternate methods of construction? This course covers product types, performance attributes and pros and cons of each system. This course assists architects and specifiers with making the appropriate product selections based on the required level of performance.

 - 2) ASTM D 5420 Surface Indentation
 - 3) ASTM E 695 Soft Body Impact
 - 4) Annex A1 Hard Body Impact
- Compare the performance of standard, abuse resistant and impact resistant gypsum products and identify specialized applications for each product type.

The facilitator utilizes a PowerPoint presentation. Samples, test data and exercises are used based on the topic of discussion. The program concludes with an optional ten question quiz.
